Tour Conditions and Pricing: This tour requires a minimum of 14 travelers to operate, and HMS reserves the right to cancel by December 1, 2008, with no liability. The tour price of \$2,499 per person is based on two to a room (\$400 supplement for a single room). A \$500 per person deposit is required to hold a reservation. Final payment must be received by December 1, 2008, or space is released and the cancellation penalty applied.

Refunds: A full refund minus a \$250 per person service fee will be provided if written cancellation is received between the date of booking and November 30, 2008. No refunds will be made for cancellations received on or after December 1, 2008. There will be no refunds for any unused portion of the tour.

Changes: For any name changes after the tour final payment is made, a \$50 per person service fee applies.

Notice: All changes, cancellations, refunds or requests must be made in writing. Changes in hotel, fuel rates, surcharges or exchange rates may result in changes to the tour price.

The Company can also not be held responsible for any alteration of the group's itinerary, if such alterations become advisable or necessary for the safety and/or well being of the passenger(s). The Company cannot be held responsible for costs or other liabilities associated with any act of terrorism, war, accident, weather or any act of God. The Company reserves the right to refuse, accept or retain any person as a member of the group. If offered facilities or services become unavailable for reasons beyond our control, we reserve the right to substitute comparable facilities or services as available.
